Finished Quilt Approximately: 40" x 40"

**Whitetail Valley** fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3762

**Fabric Requirements:** Based on 44" wide fabric

One **Whitetail Valley** panel (#8924-6)

2/3 yard black swirl (#9135-8)

1/2 yard brown deer (#8927-95)

1/3 yard dark green tonal (#9123-65)

5/8 yards brown bark (#8245-9)

5/8 yard green tonal (#9123-6)

1/3 yard cream tonal (#9123-9)

5/8 yard foliage (#8928-6)

5/8 yard brown leaf (#8929-95)

1/3 yard green leaf (#8929-6)

1-1/2 yards backing (#8926-6 all-over deer suggested)

42" x 42" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

**Cutting Directions:** All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **black swirl** fabric:

Cut one 5-7/8" x 44" strip then recut into two 5-7/8" squares\*

Cut four 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

From the **brown deer** fabric:

Cut two 1-3/4" x 44" strips recut into two 1-3/4" x 18" and two 1-3/4" x 20-1/2" strips

Cut one 5-7/8" x 44" strip then recut into four 5-7/8" squares\*

From the **dark green tonal** fabric:

Cut one 5-7/8" x 44" strip then recut into six 5-7/8" squares\*

From the **brown bark** fabric:

Cut two 5-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into eight 5-7/8" squares\*\*

From the **green tonal** fabric:

Cut two 5-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into eight 5-7/8" squares\*

From the **cream tonal** fabric:

Cut one 5-7/8" x 44" strip then recut into four 5-7/8" squares\*

From the **foliage** fabric:

Cut two 5-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into eight 5-7/8" squares\*

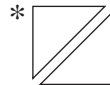
From the **brown leaf** fabric:

Cut two 5-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into six 5-7/8" squares\*

From the **green leaf** fabric:

Cut one 5-7/8" x 44" strip then recut into two 5-7/8" squares\*

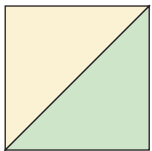
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## Quilt Center:

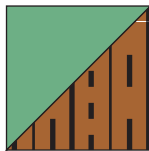
1. Trim the pillow panel to 18" square.
2. Stitch a 1-3/4" x 18" brown deer strip to right and left sides of the pillow panel. Add the 1-3/4" x 20-1/2" brown deer strips to the top and bottom of the panel.

## Pieced Border:

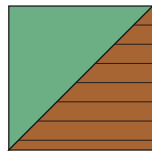
1. Use the 5-7/8" half-square triangles to make the following half-square triangle units as shown:

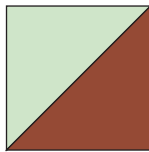

2. Using triangle sets, piece four corner units.



3. Make two of each side unit as shown.



4. Using the quilt diagram as reference, and keeping the bark fabric directional (running vertically), add the side borders.

5. Sew the corner units to the remaining units then add these to the top and bottom of quilt.

## Finishing:

1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

2. Prepare binding from four 2-1/2" x 44" strips of black swirl. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.

5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
